

‘flying on silver wings’

options are available. Typically the following can be done:

- Application of decals with company branding to the exterior of the aircraft. Should these decals cover existing aircraft decals then the replacement of the existing livery decals is for client cost once the company branding decals have been removed.
- Company logo can be embroidered onto the Antimacassars (headrest covers).
- Company branded gift bag containing items such as hair brush, eye covers, socks, tissues, toothbrush and toothpaste can be arranged.

The following items with company branding can also be supplied: lip-ice, small sun protection lotion, small chocolate, soap, hand cream, ear plugs.

A promotional DVD containing video programming depicting the classic airliners used for tours can also be supplied.

The following is a brief description of the aircraft used:

The Douglas DC-3 Dakota is representative of the DC-3s that began service with South African Airways during the 1940s. Their main task nowadays is a leisurely one, taking passengers on low-level nostalgia trips – specifically safaris throughout Southern Africa to exotic places like the Victoria Falls and many of the private game lodges. The aircraft seats up to 24 passengers.

DC-3s have always been at the forefront in the area of passenger comfort and this is evident when one steps on board. Durable, reliable, responsive, dependable – these are the traits that make the DC-3 one of the most respected and loved aircraft the world has ever known.

The Douglas DC-4 Skymaster was delivered to South African Airways in 1946 and, after 20 years of sterling service, some were transferred to the South African Air Force.

The DC-4s returned to civilian service in the early 1990s, complementing the fleet of Dakotas, and their task too is a leisurely one, performing classic airliner charter work. The DC-4s are great favourites in the tourism industry, venturing as far as North America and Europe. The aircraft seat 50 passengers each, in a business class configuration. The DC-4s range of more than 3 000 kms puts it in easy reach of exotic destinations such as central and east Africa as well as many of the tropical islands in the Indian Ocean.

With the advent of the low-cost, no frills airlines, Skyclass returns passengers to the era of what flying used to be – silver service, and where the flight was part of the experience, not just a journey to get to the destination. □
